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## LEGAL NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

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The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct a public meeting on Thursday, November 17, 2016, to present the proposed roadway improvements for FM 2275 in Gregg County. The meeting will be held from 5-7 p.m. at Spring Hill High School Gym located at 2800 East George Richey Road in Longview, TX. It will be in an open house “come and go” format with no formal presentation.

The purpose of the meeting is to gather public input on the preferred alternative for the project. The project’s limits are from FM 3272 in White Oak, east to SH 300 in Longview. The proposed work includes widening the existing two lane pavement structure to four lanes with a flush median. This project will require new right-of-way from adjacent property owners.

Exhibits showing the preferred alternative for the proposed project will be presented at the meeting. Representatives from TxDOT and its consultant will be available at the meeting to answer individual questions. The preferred alternative will be available for review online at <http://www.txdot.gov/inside-txdot/projects/studies/tyler/fm2275.html> and at the TxDOT Tyler District Office, 2709 W. Front Street, Tyler and at the Longview Area Office, 4549-A W. Loop 281, Longview. TxDOT offices are open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.
