## **US 59 from SL 463 to FM 1686 NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), Yoakum District, will conduct a public meeting on Thursday, July 7, 2016, to present the proposed roadway improvements for US 59 in Victoria County. The meeting will be held from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the University of Houston – Victoria located in the University North Building, Room 114 at 3007 N. Ben Wilson, Victoria, Texas, 77901. Parking will be available in Lot T, please see following campus map for more information. The Public Meeting will be in an open house “come and go” format with no formal presentation.

The purpose of the meeting is to gather public input on the proposed improvements. The proposed project’s limits are from State Loop (SL) 463 in Victoria to Farm to Market (FM) 1686 in Telferner. The proposed work includes adding one-way frontage roads, an overpass and additional ramps, and upgrading this section of US 59 to meet interstate standards. Improvements will improve safety and enhance mobility.

The public is invited to attend the meeting to view project maps, visit with team members, ask questions, and share comments. Comments may be submitted using any of the following methods:


