**Notice of Availability
Finding of No Significant Impact
US 77 from 1.04 mi West of US 87 to 0.52 mi East of FM 1685
Victoria, Victoria County, Texas
CSJ: 2350-01-041**

This notice is to advise the public that the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) has issued a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the proposed improvements to US 77 from 1.04 miles West of US 87 to 0.52 mile East of FM 1685 in Victoria, Victoria County, Texas.

The proposed project would widen US 77 from two lanes undivided to four lanes divided for a length of approximately 2.49 miles. The proposed expansion to a four-lane divided facility would match the existing mainlanes of US 77 to the north and south and eliminate a bottleneck on the roadway. The new roadway and bridges would have four 12-foot travel lanes (two in each direction), 10-foot outside shoulders, and four-foot inside shoulders. The expansion would take place on the southeast side of the highway. At the seven bridge locations, an additional bridge structure would be built adjacent to the existing bridge to carry the new lanes. Drainage would be accomplished via roadside ditches. The project would be constructed entirely within the approximately 350 foot wide existing right-of-way.
