The Texas Transportation Plan (TTP) 2050 is the department's performance-based multimodal statewide long-range transportation plan. The TTP is a policy document updated every 4 years that is intended to guide the department's planning and programming decisions. Stakeholder and public involvement are key in ensuring the TTP represents and addresses the concerns of the entire State of Texas. The TTP 2050 includes performance measures, transportation goals, and scenario planning, and analyzes modal needs out to 2050.

b. Discussion of the draft 2020 Unified Transportation Program ([Presentation](#))

The Unified Transportation Program (UTP) is a 10-year statewide plan for transportation project development. Staff will facilitate a discussion of the draft 2020 UTP.
