



Public Open House Notice
I-27 Potter and Randall Counties

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Amarillo District in conjunction with the Amarillo Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) will conduct a public open house for the proposed I-27 Operational Improvements. The project limits are from 45th Street to I-40 in Potter and Randall Counties, Texas.

This open house is scheduled for Tuesday, June 18, 2019, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Washington Avenue Christian Church, 3800 S Washington Street, Amarillo, Texas 79110. The open house will convene with a short presentation from TxDOT at 6:00 p.m. Exhibit review, comments, and questions will be welcome after the presentation concludes. TxDOT personnel will be onsite to answer questions regarding the project.

The proposed project consists of adding operational improvements along I-27, including auxiliary lanes, intersection improvements, ramp reconfigurations, and the reconstruction of grade separations over intersecting cross streets. The proposed project will also provide bike and pedestrian accommodations.

The open house will provide exhibits which include the proposed location, general proposed right-of-way (ROW) footprint, interchange improvements, and the interim build configuration. The final determination of the ROW needed or residential/business relocation requirements will not be known until the schematic is refined.

All interested residents are invited to attend this public open house. The public open house will be conducted in English. Persons interested in attending the meeting who have special communication or accommodation needs, or need an interpreter, are encouraged to contact Sysavath "CC" Sysombath, Project Manager, TxDOT Amarillo District at (806) 356-3380. Requests should be made no later than two (2) days prior to the public open house. TxDOT will make every reasonable effort to accommodate these needs. Public comments, after the presentation, may be submitted in writing at the scheduled meeting. Comments need to be postmarked no later than fifteen (15) calendar days following the public open house date, which is Wednesday, July 3, 2019.
