




# SH 15 Bridge Replacement– Project Scope

## ■ Project Scope

- Replacement of bridge
  - Long-Lasting, Durable, Low-Maintenance Pavement
- Maintain 2-lane SH 15 typical section
- Drainage Improvements
- Sidewalk - pedestrian accommodations
- No Additional Right-Of-Way Required

# Overall Project Timeline




# TxDOT Bridge Replacement Overview

- Estimated project duration: 1.5 years

## Construction Phase of Roadway Project to Include:


- Phased Construction

# Existing Typical Section





EXISTING BRIDGE TYPICAL SECTION

# Bridge Removal in Phase I of Construction





# Phase I Construction Traffic Control


