

### Overview of Project

**Limits:** SW 9th Avenue to FM 1719 (N. Western Street)

**Scope of Work:** The proposed project consists of converting an existing 2-lane roadway to a 4-lane freeway facility with ramps, one-way frontage roads, grade separations over intersecting cross streets and railroad. The proposed project will also provide bike and pedestrian accommodations.

The virtual public hearing will provide exhibits which include: the proposed location of the corridor center-line and general proposed right-of-way (ROW) footprint; configuration and location of interchanges; bicycle and pedestrian accommodations; and the interim and ultimate build configuration.

Early 2019: Schematic Design + Environmental Planning

May 21, 2019: Public Open House

June 23, 2020: Virtual Public Hearing

Late 2020: Final Environmental Decision
