The Texas Department of Transportation (“TxDOT”) and the Amarillo Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) are proposing improvements to State Loop 335 (SL 335) Segment C-1 from SW 9th Avenue to FM 1719 (N. Western Street) in Potter County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an on-line virtual public hearing on the proposed project. The virtual hearing will be held on **Tuesday, June 23, 2020** at 6:00 p.m. Log onto the virtual public hearing at the following web address at the date and time indicated above: <http://tiny.cc/SL335VirtualPublicHearing>. Project staff will give a presentation regarding the project. The presentation will include both audio and visual components. If you do not have internet access, you may call (806) 356-3294 to ask questions about the project and access project materials at any time during the project development process. Members of the public may call (806) 553-2725 to provide verbal comments from 6:30 p.m on **Tuesday, June 23, 2020** until **Wednesday, July 8, 2020**. Verbal comments will be limited to 3 minutes. Formal written comments may also be provided by mail or email as explained below. All verbally provided comments and timely written comments submitted by mail or email will be included as part of the official record for this hearing and project and will be considered by TxDOT. Responses to comments will be prepared by TxDOT and included as part of the hearing and project record.

The proposed 5.8-mile project consists of converting an existing 2-lane roadway to a 4-lane freeway facility with ramps, one-way frontage roads, grade separations over intersecting cross streets and railroad. The proposed project in Potter County will also provide bike and pedestrian accommodations. The public hearing will provide exhibits which include the proposed location of the corridor centerline and general proposed right-of-way (ROW) footprint; configuration and location of interchanges; bicycle and pedestrian accommodations; and both the interim and ultimate build configurations.

Although additional right-of-way would be required, no residential or non-residential structures are anticipated to be displaced at this time. Information concerning services and benefits available to affected property owners and information about the tentative schedule for right-of-way acquisition and construction can be obtained from the TxDOT district office by calling (806) 356-3294.

Any environmental documentation or studies, maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection by appointment by calling (806) 356-3200 Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. at the TxDOT Amarillo District Office located at 5715 Canyon Drive, Amarillo, Texas, 79110. To view public hearing and project materials, go to www.txdot.gov and search “Amarillo State Loop 335 Public Hearing” at the date and time indicated above.

TxDOT makes every reasonable effort to accommodate the needs of the public. The virtual public hearing will be in English. If you have a special communication accommodation or need for an interpreter, a request can be made.
