



Notice of Open House
U.S. Highway (US) 54 Dalhart Roadway Rehabilitation Project
The City of Dalhart, Hartley, and Dallam Counties

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) in conjunction with City of Dalhart and Hartley and Dallam counties will conduct an open house regarding the rehabilitation of US 54 through the City of Dalhart in Hartley and Dallam counties.

The open house is scheduled for **Tuesday, July 9, 2019**, from **6 p.m. to 8 p.m.** at the Rita Blanca Coliseum located at 2222 West Farm-to-Market Road 281, Dalhart, Texas, 79022. The open house will convene with a short presentation from TxDOT at 6 p.m. The remainder of the open house meeting time will be dedicated to participant review of exhibits, asking questions, and providing comments on any aspect of the proposed project. TxDOT personnel will be onsite to answer questions regarding the project.

The project proposes upgrading the existing US 54 roadway by rehabilitating the existing pavement to concrete from the Rita Blanca Creek bridge to US 87 and constructing sidewalks and pedestrian accommodations from the Dalhart city limit to US 87. Improvements to existing driveways would also occur as part of the proposed project. Additional right of way will be required from one parcel on one property. There are no anticipated relocations of existing businesses or residences.

Maps and other exhibits will be displayed for public viewing.

All interested residents are invited to attend this open house and opportunity for public involvement. The open house will be conducted in English. Persons interested in attending the open house who have special communication or accommodation needs, such as the need for an interpreter, are encouraged to contact CC Sysombath at (806) 356-3200, or email: cc.sysombath@txdot.gov. Requests should be made at least two days prior to the open house. Every reasonable effort will be made to accommodate these needs.

Written comments from the public regarding this project are requested. Written comments will be accepted at the open house or may be mailed to: the Texas Department of Transportation, Attn: Brian Crawford, P.E., District Engineer – TxDOT Amarillo District, 5715 Canyon Drive, Amarillo, Texas 79110. Comments need to be postmarked no later than **Wednesday, July 24, 2019**, 15 calendar days following the open house date.

The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried out by TxDOT pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated December 16, 2014, and executed by FHWA and TxDOT.
