## Project Details - Replacement of 5 Bridges

*This project will utilize Accelerated Bridge Construction Techniques to limit the construction impact to the daily roadway users. Each of the bridges below were originally constructed in the 1930's and have timber pile bridge structures and additionally the truck loads have increased thus the need for these structures to be replaced.*

### US 83 in Hemphill County: West Fork of Horse Creek North & South Bridges

- The location is approx. 13 miles NW from Canadian (between Canadian and Perryton)
- This roadway will be open during construction via an on-site detour limited to 1-lane traffic control utilizing temporary traffic signals for each location.

### SH 15 in Hansford County: Farwell Creek Bridge and Palo Duro Creek Bridge


- The location is approx. 1.5 miles and 7 miles E from Gruver (between Gruver and Spearman)
- This roadway will be closed during construction for an estimated 21 calendar days. A detour will be signed for the traveling public for each location.

### SH 15 in Lipscomb County: Ivanhoe Creek Bridge

- The location is approx. 6 miles E from Follett (between Follett and the Okla. State Line)
- This roadway will be closed during construction for an estimated 21 calendar days. A detour will be signed for the traveling public.
