The Atlanta District of Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT-ATL) will conduct a public meeting on Thursday, January 30, 2020. The meeting will be from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., with the presentation beginning at 5:30 p.m. The meeting will be held at TxDOT, 701 East Main St., Building B, Atlanta, TX 75551. The purpose of this meeting is to provide information regarding transportation projects and programs that might affect bicycle use on the state system within the Atlanta District. The Atlanta District is made up of Bowie, Camp, Cass, Harrison, Marion, Morris, Panola, Titus, and Upshur Counties. All interested persons are invited to attend this meeting. In addition, exhibits pertaining to the existing state system and upcoming projects on the state system will be available following the public meeting at www.txdot.gov by searching "2020 Annual Bicycle Meeting".

Verbal and written comments regarding bicycle use of the state system in the Atlanta District will be submitted at the public meeting. Written comments may also be submitted or postmarked on or before Friday, February 14, 2020 to the TxDOT Atlanta District Office, Attention: Terri McCasland, Bicycle Coordinator, 701 East Main St., Atlanta, TX 75551 to be included in the public meeting record.
