



## Texas Department of Transportation Open House For the Reconstruction and Widening of FM 1735 in Titus County CSJ 1226-02-016

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will host an open house on December 4, 2018, to discuss proposed improvements to FM 1735 from SH 49 to 2.1 miles south of SH 49 in Titus County, Texas.

The proposed improvements include:

- Reconstructing FM 1735 to include two travel lanes, a center left turn lane, and two 10 foot shoulders; and
- Upgrading the intersection at SH 49.

The proposed project will improve safety and enhance mobility. Additional Right of Way will be required to construct this project.

### Open House

Anyone interested in the project is invited to attend the open house. There will be no formal presentation, so attendees can come and go at their convenience. Attendees will have the opportunity to view maps, study exhibits, ask questions, and provide comments.
