



Texas Department of Transportation Open House
For the Reconstruction and Widening of FM 989 in Bowie County

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct an open house style public meeting on Thursday, May 17, 2018, from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at Waggoner Creek Elementary School located at 6335 Gibson Lane in Texarkana, Texas. The purpose of this open house is to discuss the proposed reconstruction and widening of FM 989 from the IH 30 North Frontage Road to 0.3 miles north of Gibson Lane in Bowie County. Approximately 2.4 acres of additional right-of-way and 0.1 acres of temporary easement would be required for this project.

All interested citizens are invited to attend this open house to express their views and discuss the project. TxDOT personnel will be available to answer questions and receive written comments from those in attendance. Written comments may be submitted for a period of 15 calendar days after the open house to Project Manager Katie Martin at 701 East Main, Atlanta, Texas 75551 or email at Katie.Martin@txdot.gov.

Those interested in attending the open house that have special communication or accommodation needs are encouraged to contact the Atlanta District Planning Office at (903) 799-1309 at least two days prior to the open house. Because the open house will be conducted in English, any requests for language interpreters or other special communication needs should also be made at least two days prior to the open house. TxDOT will make every effort to accommodate these needs.
