Proposed 2019-2022 Rural Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP)

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), Atlanta District, will conduct a public meeting to solicit public comments and input to the Proposed 2019-2022 Rural Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP). The RTIP is a mechanism used by TxDOT and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) to fund projects for the next four years and includes all federally funded projects. The 2019-2022 RTIP and comment sheet may be viewed on-line at <http://www.txdot.gov> with the search word "ATLRTIP" or at the Atlanta District Office prior to the meeting.

This will be an open house meeting with no formal presentation for the Proposed 2019-2022 RTIP. The public is invited to visit anytime during the scheduled hours to view the document, ask questions and offer written comments. **The public review and comment period begins May 15, 2018 and ends June 4, 2018 at the close of business.**
