



Texas Department of Transportation Open House for the Proposed Widening of
SH 155 From 0.3 Miles East of US 259 to Glendia Drive in Upshur County
CSJ 0520-05-040

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct an open house style public meeting on Thursday, July 27, 2017, from 4:30-6:30 PM at the Ore City High School cafeteria, located at 100 Rebel Road in Ore City, Texas. The purpose of this open house is to discuss the proposed State Highway 155 roadway widening project. The project runs from 0.3 miles east of US 259 to Glendia Drive in Upshur County. The project is located approximately 3.1 miles northeast of Ore City, Texas. Approximately 0.6 acres of additional right-of-way and one 0.4 acre temporary easement would be required for this project.

All interested citizens are invited to attend this open house to express their views and discuss the project. TxDOT personnel will be available to answer questions and receive written comments from those in attendance.
