



Texas Department of Transportation Open House
For the Proposed Construction of a Grade Separation on US 59 at the
Intersection of FM 1794 in Panola County

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct an open house style public meeting on Tuesday, June 26, 2018, from 4:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. at Walnut Springs Baptist Church located at the corner of FM 1794 and FM 1186 in the Horton Community. The purpose of this open house is to discuss the proposed construction of a grade separation that would meet interstate standards at the intersection of US 59 and FM 1794 in Panola County. Approximately 33 acres of additional right-of-way and a 0.5 acre temporary easement would be required for this project.

All interested citizens are invited to attend this open house to express their views and discuss the project. TxDOT personnel will be available to answer questions and receive written comments from those in attendance. Written comments may be submitted for a period of 15 calendar days after the open house to Kenneth Williams at 300 E. Loop 390 N., Marshall, TX, 75672 or email at Kenneth.Williams@txdot.gov.

Those interested in attending the open house that have special communication or accommodation needs are encouraged to contact the Atlanta District Planning Office at (903) 799-1309 at least two days prior to the open house. Because the open house will be conducted in English, any requests for language interpreters or other special communication needs should also be made at least two days prior to the open house. TxDOT will make every effort to accommodate these needs.
