

Notice of Public Meeting

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to widen and reconstruct US 82 from 0.1 mile west of US 259 to 0.3 mile east of I-30 in De Kalb, Bowie County, Texas. The total length is approximately 11.36 miles. The purpose of the meeting is to receive public comments on the proposed project. The public meeting will be an open house, come-and-go format with no formal presentation. It will be held on:



The proposed improvements include widening US 82 to a 4-lane roadway with a continuous center left turn lane. In order to accommodate pedestrians, sidewalks are proposed within the city limits of De Kalb. In addition, a portion of the project will include a drainage design featuring a new storm drain system with inlets. Additional right-of-way will be required for sections from 0.1 mile west of US 259 to FM 1840, and from SH 98 to 0.3 mile east of I-30.

Maps and drawings reflecting the proposed project will be displayed at the public meeting. After the public meeting, maps showing the project location, design, and other information regarding the project will be available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. at the TxDOT Atlanta District Office, 701 East Main St., Atlanta, TX 75551. In addition, exhibits, maps and other information will be available following the public meeting at www.txdot.gov by searching “US 82 De Kalb”.

Verbal and written comments regarding the proposed widening project will be submitted at the public meeting. Written comments may also be submitted or postmarked on or before, Wednesday, November 20, 2019, to the TxDOT Atlanta District Office, (Attention: Katie Martin, P.E., 701 East Main St, Atlanta, TX 75551) to be included in the public meeting record.
