


# Notice of Public Meeting

**FM 989**  
**CSJ: 1231-01-052**  
**Bowie County, Texas**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to widen and reconstruct FM 989 from I-30 south Frontage Road to US 82 in Nash, Bowie County, TX. The total length is approximately 0.56 miles. The purpose of the meeting is to present alternatives and receive public comments on the proposed project. The public meeting will be an open house format with no formal presentation. It will be held on:

The goal of the project is to widen FM 989 from a 4-lane roadway to a 4-lane roadway with a center left turn lane. In order to accommodate cyclists and pedestrians, bicycle lanes and sidewalks are proposed to be included in this project. In addition, this project would also include a drainage design featuring a new storm drain system with inlets. Additional right-of-way will be required for the proposed project.

Maps and drawings reflecting the proposed project will be displayed at the public meeting. The meeting will be an open house format allowing interested stakeholders to come and go at their convenience. Maps showing the project location, design, and other information regarding the project are available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. at the TxDOT Atlanta District Office, 701 East Main Street, Atlanta, Texas 75551.

Verbal and written comments regarding the proposed project may be presented at the public meeting.
