

# US 82/FM 989 Public Meeting Welcome and Instructions



## Welcome

Welcome to the Texas Department of Transportation Atlanta District's US 82/FM 989 Virtual Public Meeting, we appreciate your attendance. In this meeting, we will be presenting 2 projects in the Nash/Texarkana area. They are on US 82 and FM 989 and include the US 82/FM 989 intersection.

The proposed US 82 project consists of widening US 82 from 0.9 mile west of FM 989 in Nash to I-369 (US 59) West Frontage Road in Texarkana. The total length is approximately 2.80 miles on US 82, and 0.26 miles on FM 989.

The proposed FM 989 project consists of widening an existing .56-mile long section of FM 989 in Nash in Bowie County, Texas from I-30 South Frontage Road to 0.1 mile north of US 82.

The purpose of this meeting is to provide an update on the projects, allow you to review the selected designs for each roadway, and for you to provide comments and feedback. A Comment Station with additional information is included as the last station in the meeting room.

## Instructions

So first, let's go over some virtual room navigation instructions. To get around in the meeting room, you can use the site map provided in the upper left-hand corner to identify and click on the station you would like to visit. This site map can be minimized by clicking the x in the upper left-hand corner. Or, to visit each station in order, simply click the double right arrow on the right side of each page to advance through the room.

To zoom in and out, you can scroll your mouse backwards or forwards, hold your left mouse button down and move your mouse to the right or left, or click the + icon to zoom in or the – icon to zoom out at the bottom of the page. The icon with the screen and arrow at the bottom of the page allows you to view each board or station in full screen - click the icon to do so, and to return to normal view, either hit the escape (ESC) button on your keyboard or click the icon again.

To zoom in on a board in a station, click the eye icon. To download a board, fact sheet, or other meeting materials, click the icon with the down arrow. Items will open in another window as a .pdf file that you can also zoom in on or choose to save and print.

To play the video, which is a proposed drive thru of both the US 82 and the FM 989 corridor, simply click it to play, and click at any time during the video to pause. Once the video is complete, you can click the double right arrow on the right side of the page to advance to the next board or station. Please note that this drive thru is conceptual and preliminary, and only meant to give an idea of what the project could look like. The final constructed project may differ based on a number of factors.

## **Schematics Instructions**

The schematics provide information about potential property impacts as a result of proposed changes to right-of-way to accommodate the project. The pink lines are the existing right-of-way, and the blue lines are the proposed right-of-way. The file is best viewed when you download the .pdf and use the green street name signs to zoom into the general vicinity of your property. From there, you can locate your (or the property owner's) name, and zoom in further to view details.
