


US 82 West Improvement Project in Bowie County



Project Purpose and Need

The purpose of the proposed project is to improve safety, mobility, regional connectivity, and address roadway deficiencies. The proposed improvements are needed to accommodate future traffic volumes and establish continuity along the US 82 corridor.

Project Details

Project Limits: Red River County Line to 0.1 mile west of US 259

NEPA Documentation: Categorical Exclusion (CE) is anticipated

Length: Approximately 6.87 miles

ROW: Approximately 150-foot usual width

Current Estimated Cost: \$45 million (South Alternative)

Funding sources: Category 4


Proposed Improvements to US 82 West in Bowie County

The proposed project consists of widening the existing section of US 82 in Bowie County from the Red River County Line to 0.1 mile west of US 259.

When complete, this project would feature the following improvements:

- A typical section consisting of two 12-foot travel lanes in each direction, a continuous 16-foot wide paved median, and a 10-foot shoulder in each direction.
- Drainage improvements for this project would include replacement of the existing culverts and appropriate modifications to the open roadside ditches.
- The South Alternative includes relocation of the existing trail approximately 25 feet to the south. The trail relocation will include the clearing and grading necessary to reestablish the trail similar to its existing condition.
