



PROJECT PURPOSE AND NEED

PURPOSE


The purpose of the proposed project is to reduce congestion and improve mobility for FM 734 (Parmer Lane) by providing additional roadway capacity to meet future traffic demands due to population growth and increased traffic volumes.

NEED

The existing roadway does not adequately accommodate current and projected traffic volumes.





PROPOSED FM 734 IMPROVEMENTS

- **EXPAND FM 734 FROM 4 TRAVEL LANES TO 6 TRAVEL LANES (3 IN EACH DIRECTION) WITHIN THE EXISTING RIGHT OF WAY**
- **IMPROVE INTERSECTIONS WITH ADDITIONAL TURN LANES WHERE NECESSARY**
- **IN COOPERATION WITH THE CITY OF AUSTIN, IMPROVE WATER QUALITY FOR STORMWATER RUNOFF**
- **PROVIDE SIDEWALKS THROUGHOUT CORRIDOR AND A DEDICATED BIKE/PEDESTRIAN PATH CONNECTING FM 734 TO THE BRUSHY CREEK REGIONAL TRAIL**








AVERY RANCH TO SH 45


