Letter from Kory Keller, Task Force Chair

Dear Fellow Community Member,

On behalf of the Gillespie County Relief Route Task Force, welcome to the first public workshop for the Fredericksburg Relief Route Study. This is the first in a series of public workshops, open houses and meetings that are planned in conjunction with the current Fredericksburg Relief Route Study.

Tonight, we are focusing on prioritizing goals and objectives for the potential US 290 relief route. These goals and objectives will become the basis for evaluating our options, so your input is extremely important. We are also asking for your help in identifying potential route options. Stations are set up where you can draw suggested routes on maps.

With your input and ideas in hand, over the next few months the Gillespie Relief Route Task Force will work with the study team to develop conceptual route options and evaluation criteria. In the fall, a second Fredericksburg Relief Route Study public workshop will be held to present the conceptual route options, solicit input on the options, and continue the dialogue about the potential relief route and its future.

The Gillespie County Relief Route Task Force has been charged by the City of Fredericksburg and Gillespie County with exploring the need for, identifying, and developing a viable solution for the Fredericksburg relief route. Our job is to facilitate our community through a decision-making process. To that end, the Gillespie County Relief Route Task Force is working hard to facilitate a community-wide discussion. To be successful, the ultimate solution must reflect the desires and values of the community while addressing the mobility and safety issues that we now experience.
