

I-35 FROM RM 2243 TO SE INNER LOOP OPEN HOUSE



Join us for an open house to discuss proposed improvements on I-35 from RM 2243 to SE Inner Loop in Williamson County. Team members will be on hand to answer questions and provide information.

The purpose of the proposed project is to increase safety and mobility, including eliminating potential conflict points between I-35 entrance and exit ramps. The proposed improvements include:

- Replace the existing bridge at RM 2243
- Improve the existing I-35 southbound frontage road from RM 2243 to north of SE Inner Loop
- Improve entrance/exit ramps along the I-35 southbound frontage road between RM 2243 and SE Inner Loop
- Provide a northbound to southbound U-turn bridge
- Improve bicycle and pedestrian paths
