On Sept. 17, 2020, a pre-recorded video presentation, maps, drawings and other project information will be available at Mobility35openhouse.com for review. The virtual public meeting allows the public the opportunity to review and comment on the project.

The purpose of the project is to improve mobility and safety for all users of I-35, while minimizing the need for additional right of way and impacts to the community and environment. The proposed improvements include:

- Constructing an innovative intersection at I-35 and SH 29
- Constructing SH 29 intersection bypass lanes
- Reconstructing entrance and exit ramps throughout the corridor
- Extending entrance and exit lanes along the I-35 mainlanes between entrance and exit ramps
- Improving bicycle and pedestrian paths
