**RM 2222 and RM 620**

**From RM 620 to Bonaventure Drive and Steiner Ranch Road to RM 2222**

**CSJs: 2100-01-060 and 0683-02-065**

**Travis County, Texas**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is proposing to improve RM 2222 and RM 620, from RM 620 to Bonaventure Drive, and Steiner Ranch Road to RM 2222, in Travis County, Texas. This notice advises the public that a draft environmental assessment (EA) is available for public review and that TxDOT will be conducting a public hearing on the proposed project. The hearing will be held on October Oct 26, 2017 at Vandergrift High School, 9500 McNeil Drive, Austin, Texas. Displays will be available for viewing at 5:30 p.m. with the formal hearing starting at 6:30 p.m. The purpose of the hearing is to present the planned improvements and to receive public comment on the proposed project.

The project consists of adding an outside northbound merge lane along RM 620 from Steiner Ranch Road, to a new bypass road to be constructed about a mile north of Steiner Ranch Road to RM 2222. Center-turn lanes and medians would also be built on RM 2222 between the new bypass road and RM 620. The right-of-way widths of RM 620 and RM 2222 vary from 80 to 130 feet. Approximately 7.7 acres of additional right of way would be required for the proposed project. It is anticipated that two commercial businesses and no residences may require relocation. Displays to be presented at the hearing are available Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the TxDOT Georgetown Area Office, 2727 S. Austin Ave. Georgetown, Texas, 512-930-6008. The Draft Environmental Assessment will be available at the hearing and after the hearing for review and comment.

Comments may also be faxed to (512) 832-7157. Comments must be received on or before November 10, 2017 to be part of the official hearing record.

The public hearing will be conducted in English.
