



# RM 2244 Bee Cave Road Improvement Project

The Texas Department of Transportation, in cooperation with the city of West Lake Hills, is performing improvements along a three-mile stretch of Bee Cave Road between Redbud Trail and Walsh Tarlton Lane. The purpose of these improvements is to enhance safety and mobility along this roadway.

## Improvements Include:

- Converting the four-lane roadway into a five-lane section by constructing a center-turn lane
- Adding shoulders
- Adding sidewalks

## Schedule

Construction of the project begins in November 2016 and is scheduled to be complete around summer 2019. Currently, utility providers are relocating utilities. The contractor will start with preconstruction work such as clearing the right-of-way and working on shoulders.



## Traffic Control and Lane Closures

Construction is being phased to maintain four lanes of traffic (two lanes in each direction) for most of construction. However, there will be some lane closures necessary. The project team will try to schedule most of these during non-rush hour times and the majority of lane closures will take place during night and weekend hours. Please use caution when traveling in work zones.
