The Texas Department of Transportation is conducting an open house to discuss proposed improvements to RM 620 South between SH 71 and Hudson Bend Road in Travis County, Texas. This project plans to address safety and mobility concerns along this section of RM 620.

## LEARN ABOUT THE PROPOSED RM 620 SOUTH PROJECT

The purpose of the open house is to share project information and updates, present proposed project information, and collect community input. Proposed improvements include:

- Widening the existing four-lane divided rural roadway to a six-lane divided urban roadway, with one additional travel lane in each direction
- Adding raised medians
- Adding a continuous bike/pedestrian shared-use path along the corridor

TxDOT will develop design options for the build alternative, compare them to the no-build alternative, and prepare an environmental study for the project.
