**FY 2019-2022 Rural Transportation Improvement Program**  
**Proposed Amendment**

The Texas Department of Transportation will conduct a public meeting to receive comments on a proposed amendment to the FY 2019-2022 Rural Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP) for Blanco, Gillespie, Llano, Lee and Mason counties. The proposed amendment will include Project US 290, from the Bastrop County line to Navarro Street in Lee County, that will reconstruct the existing 4-lane undivided roadway to 4-lane divided roadway in the FY 2019-2022 RTIP. The RTIP is a mechanism used by TxDOT and FHWA to fund projects for the next four years and includes all federally funded projects. You are encouraged to attend the public meeting which will be held from 4 to 6 p.m. on the following date and location:
