9/27/2018	George Ochsner	Please provide a driveway to the two new gates I have on my property. Check where water ponds in front of my west driveway. The guard rail is too close to my west driveway. Can it be moved?
	TxDOT Response	Driveways will be reconstructed with as-like materials of existing. There appear to be no culverts under the existing driveways therefore the driveways will be graded to have swale for drainage. The metal beam guard fence (MBGF) is per design criteria and appears to not impact driveway. Area of question Station 160+00 to 170+00.
9/27/2018	Edward Morgan	Please investigate adding a shoulder to Highway 16 at the entrance to the Llano Airport. There is no way to slow down to turn into the airport (heading north) without risking being hit in the rear. Please add a shoulder or a turn lane.
	TxDOT Response	This scope of this project is only to add passing lanes to SH 29
9/27/2018	Beverly & Gary Gatliff	We need a caution light for people to be safer turning from SH 29 to RM 2241
	TxDOT Response	A flashing signal has been installed at this location
9/27/2018	James & Melinda Wheeler	Phase III: Eastbound right hand lane at CR 202 needs extra wide shoulder to turn onto CR 202 because the turn must be taken at 15 to 20 mph because the turn is greater than 90 degrees. Phase II: The designated turn lane on east bound lanes at RM 2241 is great.
	TxDOT Response	The shoulder width throughout the project has been increased from 5' to 10'. In addition the right turn radius from SH 29 to CR 202 will be increased.
9/27/2018	Mary Michalewicz	I own property in Indian Bend II. I'm concerned about the entrance entering and exiting.
	TxDOT Response	A review was conducted of this area and the edge of traveled way will only be about 12' closer to the property than now to accommodate a standard length passing lane in this area. All work will be performed within the TxDOT right-of-way.
9/27/2018	Irna & Kevin Gatliff	Add a blinking light at SH 29 & RM 2241 intersection.
	TxDOT Response	A flashing signal has been installed at this location
9/27/2018	TxDOT Response	I would strongly suggest that the intersection of CR 202 and SH 29 (proposed Phase III) be considered for re-alignment to a perpendicular ingress and egress from that county road and vice versa.
	TxDOT Response	The county is responsible for CR 202 and TxDOT submitted a preliminary design for realignment of this roadway for their consideration. At this time they stated there are not funds available. However the widening of the SH 29 shoulder and increasing the right turn radius from SH 29 will improve the situation.
9/27/2018	Debra Peters	I heartily approve of the planned widening of SH 29 between Fuzzy's corner and Llano. This is not the entirety of improvements I would like to see but it is a great start.

The Texas Department of Transportation is proposing improvements on SH 29 from RM 1431 to RM 2241 in Llano County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an open house style public meeting on the proposed project. The open house will be held on Thursday, Sept.27, 2018, at the East Llano County Annex meeting room at 8347 FM 1431, Buchanan Dam, TX 78609. Displays will be available for viewing between 5 and 7 p.m. The purpose of the open house is to present the planned improvements and to receive public comment on the proposed project.

Within the project limits, SH 29 is currently one 12 foot-lane in each direction with shoulders of variable width. The proposed project would widen SH 29 to add alternating passing lanes and 10 ft. shoulders throughout the project limits. The project would not require new right of way (ROW) and no displacements are anticipated.

Environmental studies, maps showing the project location and design, a tentative construction schedule, and other information regarding the project will be available for inspection at the open house. Comments from the public regarding the project may be submitted at the open house or by mail to the project manager, John Burke, at the TxDOT Austin District Office; 7901 North I-35, Austin, TX, 78753. Comments may also be submitted by email to John.Burke@txdot.gov. Comments must be received on or before Oct. 12, 2018 to be part of the official project record.



Danish Students Visit Llano

On Monday September 10th, a group of fifty-four high school students from the city of Roskilde, Denmark visited Llano. The Danish students are all seniors in high school and major in international economics and mass media communications. "They want to learn about America, they want to learn about the south, the rural American experience that they see in films and on T.V, so what better place than Llano," said Brian Billich, the Global Learning Manager for Continuing Education at Austin Community College. Brian Billich coordinated with Llano High School Theater Instructor, Caleb Straus, to bring together the visiting Danes and local Llano students.

to the conflicts in the middle-east and North Africa, Denmark has seen a marked increase in immigrants from those regions and is in the midst of immigration policy reform.
"It was really interesting to see what kind of questions they asked and how much they knew about our culture, how similar and dissimilar it was in certain ways, especially on gun control. It's almost polar opposites, it's very difficult to get a gun over there, and it's easy enough to get a gun over here.", said Andrew Cantrell, a Llano High School Theater student, when asked about his interview with one of the groups of Danish students. Denmark gun policy allows for the ownership of rifles and shotguns for hunting and sport shooting, but prohibits the possession of handguns and assault weapons.

Terry "Tex" Toler, Main Street Manager, gave a brief history lesson on the Lan-Tex Theater for the Danish students before they held a Q&A with the sheriff of Llano County, William Blackburn and Donny Carpenter, City of Llano Code Enforcement Officer. Sheriff Blackburn shared his background as a game warden and his experiences in Mexico and on the border, and fielded questions on: gun ownership in the U.S., gun prices, the purpose of owning firearms,

and the recent demonstrations on gun control policy by student activists.
"This is what American cities look like to us, it's what we've seen in the movies...this is a real Western town.", said Synne Larsen when asked why they came to Llano. The Danish public school system facilitates annual global student travel as part of their curriculum, and of all the places in the world they could have gone, they chose Llano.

Commissioners approve budget with lower tax rate

In the Commissioner's Court meeting on September 10th, the budget for 2019 was discussed. The estimated income from new taxes will be \$16,153,831 with expenditures expected to be \$14,637,217. They expect to start with a balance brought forward of \$6,398,931. The tax rate for next year will go down from 0.30212 percent per \$100 evaluation to 0.2865



PROJECT DEVELOPMENT TIMELINE*








Existing and Proposed Typical Sections





A Proposed Typical Section: Left-turn Lane




B Proposed Typical Section: Side-by-side Passing Lanes














Existing and Proposed Typical Sections




Existing Typical Section



Proposed Typical Section: Left-turn Lane




Proposed Typical Section: Side-by-side Passing Lanes




Proposed Typical Section: Single Lane




Proposed Typical Section: Center-turn Lane




Proposed Typical Section: Westbound Passing Lane




Proposed Typical Section: Eastbound Passing Lane



Proposed Typical Section: Center-turn Lane with Passing Lane












