Virtual Public Meeting
STATE HIGHWAY 71 AT MCALLISTER ROAD INTERSECTION STUDY

Bastrop County, Texas**

The Texas Department of Transportation will host a virtual public meeting to gather input from the public on the State Highway 71 at McAllister Road intersection study in Bastrop County, Texas. The study aims to enhance safety and mobility in the area.

Study overview:

- Evaluating possible short-, medium- and long-term safety and operational improvements.
- The intersection is located east of the city of Bastrop in Bastrop County, Texas.

Proposed improvements:

- Improved signage
- Improved pavement markings
- A restricted-crossing U-turn (RCUT) intersection

The virtual public meeting will launch on www.txdot.gov, keyword search "SH 71 at McAllister Road" beginning at 6 p.m. on Thursday, Oct. 29, 2020. The meeting will include a pre-recorded video presentation explaining the proposed improvements. Additional project-related materials will also be available. The presentation will be available at www.txdot.gov, keyword search "SH 71 at McAllister Road" until Friday, Nov. 13, 2020. The virtual public meeting will be conducted in English.
