

Pursuant to Transportation Code, §21.111, and Title 43, Texas Administrative Code, §30.209, the Texas Department of Transportation will conduct a public hearing to receive comments from interested parties concerning approval of financial assistance at the following locations: City of Arlington, City of Bowie, City of Bryan, City of Cleveland, City of Coleman, City of Corsicana, City of Denton, City of Devine, Moore County, City of Edinburg, City of Galveston, City of Granbury, City of Grand Prairie, City of Hillsboro, City of Lancaster, City of Mineral Wells, City of New Braunfels, Gray County (Pampa), Cameron County, Gaines County, City of Stanton, City of Sweetwater, City of Taylor, City of Temple, City of Uvalde, Wilbarger County, and City of Weslaco.

The public hearing will be a virtual meeting held on Thursday, July 2, 2020, at 10:00 a.m. Any interested person may appear and offer comments, either orally or in writing; however, questioning of those making presentations will be reserved exclusively to the presiding officer as may be necessary to ensure a complete record. While any person with pertinent comments will be granted an opportunity to present them during the course of the hearing, the presiding officer reserves the right to restrict testimony in terms of time and repetitive content. Organizations, associations, or groups are encouraged to present their commonly held views, and same or similar comments, through a representative member where possible.
