

What is this Project About?

The Texas Department of Transportation Beaumont District is proposing to widen the section of US 90 between the cities of Devers and Liberty. The project is needed to meet increasing transportation demand, to meet current design standards, and to address safety. Additionally, it is needed to provide uniformity and consistency by providing continuity between Beaumont and Liberty.


The approximately 11 mile project would include:

- Reconstructing and widening the existing rural roadway from a two-lane facility to a four-lane divided arterial by adding one 12-foot wide main lane in each direction, and 10-foot outside shoulders,
- Providing turn lanes or turn bays in certain locations,
- Replacing existing bridges and building new bridges to handle one-way travel in each direction, and
- Widening the right-of-way (ROW) width from 120 feet (existing) to 250 feet (proposed) to accommodate the additional roadway capacity. (Note- this additional ROW could potentially displace residential and commercial properties.)
