Project Purpose and Need

Purpose

- Improve mobility
- Relieve hurricane evacuation congestion

Need

- Lack of connectivity without frontage roads
- Lack of sufficient hurricane evacuation capacity

Proposed Project

- Construct continuous northbound and southbound frontage roads between Tram Road and Cooks Lake Road
- Construct new frontage road bridges over Pine Island Bayou
- Remove the existing U-turn located south of Pine Island Bayou
- Reconstruct the boat ramp approximately 30 feet upstream of the existing location
- No additional right-of-way or easements are required
- No commercial or residential displacements

Next Steps and Timeline*

Spring 2017:

- Public comment period ends Wednesday, April 26, 2017
- Public Hearing Summary completed
- Environmental clearance
- Project available for contract bid (Letting)

Summer 2017:

- Construction scheduled to begin

Construction Duration: 19 to 20 months
