





# ADA Self-Evaluation

- Spring 2017 – Engineering interns evaluated 5.6 miles of sidewalks and curb ramps
- December 2017 – Engineering staff met with Brazos Valley Center for Independent Living (BVCIL) to discuss future evaluations
- Spring 2018 – Intern to evaluate downtown walking tour routes



# ADA Transition Plan

- January 2017 – March 2018: Municipal Office Building ADA entrance and parking lot modifications
- August 2017: Replacement of Copperfield Drive sidewalk from Williamsburg Dr to Canterbury Dr (complaint by Copperfield HOA)
- CIP projects with sidewalk replacement:
  - Old Hearne Road/Wilkes Street Reconstruction
  - Saint Joseph Hospital Area Improvements
  - South College Avenue Rehabilitation
  - Traffic Signal Replacement at Carter Creek Parkway and Villa Maria Road
  - West 26<sup>th</sup> Street Rehabilitation



  - Rustling Oaks Drive (speed hump)
  - Trophy Drive (speed hump)
  - Wayside Drive (choker, splitter island)
  - College View Drive (speed humps)
