



The Texas Department of Transportation Bryan District will conduct a public meeting on Tuesday, June 5, 2018, between 4:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. at the Jewett Civic Center at 111 N Robinson in Jewett, Texas. The purpose of this meeting is to receive input about the proposed widening of US 79 from west of IH 45 to west of FM 1512 in Leon County, Texas. The meeting will be held in an open house format so the public can come and go at their convenience. Maps showing the proposed preliminary alternatives will be on display and TxDOT staff will be available to discuss the project. No formal presentation is planned.

The proposed project is expected to increase safety and mobility. The proposed project would require the acquisition of right of way and the amount is being determined.
