To combat the spread of COVID-19, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will be conducting a virtual public meeting for the proposed 2021-2024 Rural Transportation Improvement Program (Rural TIP) for the Brownwood District.

The virtual public meeting pre-recorded presentation will be available for viewing on Thursday, May 28, 2020 by 5 p.m. This virtual meeting format (no in-person meeting) includes a pre-recorded video presentation and comment opportunity. The Rural TIP materials will be available for viewing until the comment deadline below.

Pursuant to *Title 43 Texas Administrative Code, Section 16.102*, this meeting is being held to receive public comments on the proposed 2021-2024 Brownwood District Rural TIP. The Rural TIP includes all projects to be federally funded during the next four years within the Brownwood District, which includes: Brown, Coleman, Comanche, Eastland, Lampasas, McCulloch, Mills, San Saba, and Stephens counties. The Rural TIP is the first step to producing a Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), which is the mechanism used by TxDOT and Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) to fund projects for the next four years.
