



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING  
US 183 Improvement Project  
From: Rising Star North City Limits  
To: Near Rising Star South City Limits  
Eastland County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct a second Public Meeting for the purpose of soliciting public comment on the proposed improvements to US 183 from the north city limits to near the south city limits of Rising Star in Eastland County, Texas.

The proposed improvements would include reconstructing the existing two lane urban roadway and adding a continuous center left turn lane. Concrete sidewalks, curbs and gutters would also be added. The proposed project would require additional right-of-way in limited areas, specifically on the s-curve north of downtown.

The meeting will be held at the **Rising Star High School Auditorium, 905 N. Main St., Rising Star, TX 76471** on **Tuesday, May 30, 2017**. The Public Meeting will be an Open House format between the hours of **5 – 7 p.m.** Maps showing the proposed project's location and geometric design will be available for viewing at the public meeting. This and other public information is also on file and available for public inspection at the TxDOT Brownwood District Office located at 2495 North US Highway 183, Brownwood, TX 76802. The public meeting notice and venue location will also be available online at [www.txdot.gov](http://www.txdot.gov) under Upcoming Public Hearings/Meetings.

All interested persons are invited to attend this Public Meeting and express their views on this proposed project. Written comments from the public regarding this project are requested and will be accepted for a period of 10 calendar days following the meeting. **Written comments may be submitted either in person, or by mail to: Mr. Chris Graf, P.E., Texas Department of Transportation, Brownwood District Office, 2495 North US Highway 183, Brownwood, TX 76802.**

**Written comments must be postmarked by June 9, 2017** to be included in the Public Meeting Summary. Because the Public Meeting will be conducted in English, any requests for language interpreters or other special communication needs should also be made at least three (3) days prior to the Public Meeting. The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable Federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried-out by TxDOT pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated December 16, 2014, and executed by FHWA and TxDOT.
