Driveways are being reviewed to accommodate known truck traffic. Overhead lines are not in conflict with the proposed project; issue will be reviewed with the City of Brady.

TxDOT TO CONDUCT PUBLIC MEETING FOR PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS TO US 87 IN MCCULLOCH COUNTY

October 29 meeting to be held at Ed Davenport Civic Center at 200 Country Club Road at Highway 87 West

October 16, 2019

BRADY – The Texas Department of Transportation will conduct a public meeting for the purpose of soliciting public comment on proposed improvements to US 87 in the City of Brady, McCulloch County, from Church Street to County Road (CR) 307 (Jacquelyn Ruffin Road).

The meeting will be held on Tuesday, October 29, 2019 at the Ed Davenport Civic Center 816 San Angelo Highway, Brady, TX 76825. The meeting will be an open house format from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m., and attendees are free to come and go; however, there will be a formal presentation beginning at 5:30 p.m. TxDOT staff will be on hand to answer questions before and after the presentation.

The proposed US 87 improvements would include reconstruction of the roadway, curb and gutter, illumination, sidewalks, and drainage improvements between Church Street and CR 307.

Maps showing the proposed project's location and schematic design will be available for viewing at the public meeting. This and other public information is also on file and available for public inspection at the TxDOT Brownwood District Office located at 2495 Highway 183 North, Brownwood, TX 76802.

All interested persons are invited to attend this meeting and express their views on the proposed project. Written comments from the public regarding this project are requested, and may be submitted either in person or by mail to: Jason Scantling, P.E., Texas Department of Transportation, Brownwood District Office, 2495 Highway 183 North, Brownwood, Texas 76802. Written comments must be postmarked by Friday, November 15, 2019 to be included in the public meeting summary.


