US 287 Realignment Project

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct a public meeting regarding the proposed realignment of US 287 in Memphis, TX in Hall County.

This meeting is scheduled for **Tuesday, May 29, 2018**, at **6:30 p.m.** at the Memphis Community Center located at 721 Robertson Street, Memphis, TX, 79245. The public meeting will convene with a short presentation from TxDOT at 6:30 p.m. TxDOT personnel will be onsite to answer questions regarding the project.

The project proposes realigning US 287 from Memphis South City Limits, South 1.72 miles.

Maps and other exhibits will be displayed for public viewing.

All interested residents are invited to attend this public meeting and opportunity for public involvement. The public meeting will be conducted in English. Requests should be made at least two days prior to the meeting. Every reasonable effort will be made to accommodate these needs.

Comments need to be postmarked no later than June 13, 2018, 15 calendar days following the meeting date.
