Project Location

- Project limits from US 181 to FM 3239 (Buddy Ganem Drive)
- Approximate length: 2.2 miles

Project Goals

- Improve mobility by adding travel lanes, continuous center turn lane, and pedestrian/bicycle shared-use path
- Accommodate future growth in the Portland/Gregory area

Project Details

- Addition of a 12 foot travel lane in each direction
- Addition of a continuous center turn lane
- Construction of curb and gutter, and storm drains
- Construction of a 10 foot shared use path






Existing Typical Sections




