What is the State Highway (SH) 44 Project?

- The project is located west of the City of Corpus Christi in the community of Violet. The proposed project would upgrade the existing four-lane divided highway to a four-lane divided freeway with frontage roads. On and off ramps would be constructed as well as overpasses at Farm-to-Market (FM) 24 (Violet Road) and County Road (CR) 61. Additional right-of-way (ROW) would not be required for the proposed project.
- Project Goal:
 - Enhance safety and mobility by providing additional travel lanes and connecting to existing freeway sections
- Project Details:
 - Construct freeway main lanes (two travel lanes in each direction)
 - Construct on and off ramps
 - Construct overpasses at FM 24 (Violet Road) and CR 61
