



TxDOT Open House on US 181 Project November 7, 2019

On November 7, 2019 the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), Corpus Christi District will hold a public open house to provide information, answer questions, and gather public feedback on a proposed project to widen U. S. Highway (US) 181 from Farm to Market (FM) 3239 (Buddy Ganem Drive) to FM 2986 (Wildcat Drive) in San Patricio County. The proposed project is approximately 1.5 miles long and is located within the City of Portland. TxDOT is proposing to add a continuous travel lane in both directions and rebuild entrance and exit ramps to improve safety and operations of the freeway.

Time: 5:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m.

Format: All members of the public are welcome to visit the open house to view project information, meet the project team, ask questions and provide comments on the proposed project.
