It was determined a roundabout would not be ideal at this location due to the traffic volume distribution that are anticipated to use the facility in the future.

The Horizon Economic Development Corporation (EDC) has worked with the County of El Paso to designate both Horizon Boulevard within the city limits of Horizon City and Darrington Rd. as <i>economic development corridors</i>. Thus, Horizon City supports improvements along Horizon Boulevard that enhance safety, provide transit opportunities and beautify the gateway to Horizon City.</p> <p>Another critical corridor component for the Town is the intersection of Horizon Boulevard and Darrington Rd. This busy intersection is at the geographic center of Horizon City, provides access to the newly improved Horizon Industrial Park, and to City Hall and Police Department facilities. Further, the EDC is developing conceptual plans for the vacant land just north of this intersection along Darrington Rd. to develop alternative designs that provide a vibrant, mixed-use, walkable and transit-oriented development in the heart of Horizon City. The City's goal is to ultimately transform fallow properties into feasible development.</p> <p>While the safety, mobility and connectivity of the corridor and the Horizon/Darrington intersection is key, I urge you to consider the land use and economic effects an effective intersection design will have on Horizon City as a whole. However, as presented at the meeting, an overpass is one of the more expensive options with little performance improvement when compared to the other intersection designs. ## Introduction

TxDOT El Paso District conducted a second online engagement survey as part of an overall public involvement strategy in its corridor master plan for a 9.4-mile section of Horizon Boulevard (FM 1281) from Alameda Avenue (SH 20) to Ascension Street. To better prepare for future growth, the plan will identify current and future transportation needs along Horizon Boulevard (FM 1281).



The Corridor Master Plan:

- Has defined existing transportation challenges and opportunities and will evaluate possible solutions
- Will document and evaluate the community's future vision regarding transportation
- Will develop a set of recommendations to enhance safety and mobility
- Will consider drainage implications of potential improvements

The plan includes data collection, public involvement, analysis of current and future transportation needs, and identification of potential projects. A key outcome of this process will be the identification of a set of projects for short-, mid-, and long-term implementation.


The first series of public involvement for the Horizon project was represented by the first online engagement survey. In that survey, 48 participants weighed in on their vision for the master plan. The general summary of findings was:

- Safety is the priority for this study, according to participants, with reliable mobility second.
- Excessive cars (congestion) and accidents (safety) were the most commonly used icons on the Map Marker screen
- “Traffic,” “speed,” and “growth” were commonly used words in the general comments

The second series of public involvement is represented by this, the second, online engagement survey. The development of this second survey was influenced by public input from the first survey.

## Online Engagement

An online engagement tool, MetroQuest, was developed for the second round of public involvement for the Horizon Boulevard corridor master plan. The site was composed of five screens: Welcome, Short-Term Conceptual Improvements, Mid-Term Conceptual Improvements, Long-Term Conceptual Improvements, and Stay Involved. The link was posted on [txdot.gov](http://txdot.gov) from Jan. 15, 2019 through Feb. 15, 2019. This report presents the outreach strategies and details the data results.




## Logistics and Outreach

The survey was available from Jan. 15, 2019 through Feb. 15, 2019 online at [txdot.gov](http://txdot.gov), keywords “Horizon Boulevard.” It took approximately 5 to 7 minutes to complete and was available online 24/7.

The survey was advertised via the following methods:

- A series of open houses was hosted by TxDOT on Wednesday, Jan. 30 at the Oz Glaze Senior Center (13969 Veny Webb St., in Horizon City). A business open house was from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. and a public open house was from 5-7 p.m. Another public open house was on Thursday, Jan. 31 at the Socorro City Hall/Rio Vista Complex, City Council Chambers (860 Rio Vista Road in Socorro). Approximately 52 Non-TxDOT/Non-consultant members of the public attended the Jan. 30 meetings and 22 attended the Jan. 31 meeting. A station with explanation meeting display board and a staff member were part of the open houses, where members of the public could use laptops available to complete the survey.

- Post cards and meeting informational flyers included a QR code for the Horizon Boulevard project page, where the online survey “lived.”
- The [txdot.gov](http://txdot.gov) Hearings and Meetings Schedule carried both of the Horizon Boulevard meetings and each posting included a link to the project page. The online survey “lived” on the project page, which is located on the [txdot.gov](http://txdot.gov) “Projects and Studies” schedule for the El Paso District.
- Local government: Letters were mailed to local elected officials informing them of the upcoming series of public meetings and the opportunity to complete the online survey.
- Traditional and social media: The public information officers broadcast the online survey opportunity through news releases, TV and radio interviews, email and Twitter.
- Flyers that included the QR code for the survey were distributed at public meetings for other corridor studies and other meetings.

## Survey Summary

Twenty-six participants weighed in on their vision for Horizon Boulevard. Numbers completing the survey peaked on Jan. 30 with 10. An additional 50 opened the survey link, but never progressed to the next screen.

Most of the participants (13) reported their zip code as 79928, with two reporting their zip code as 79927; and one each reported zip codes of 79902, 79904, 79905, 79907, 79912 and 79936. Five of the participants heard about the survey through media; five through an outreach event; four from

the website; two from local government officials; and two from a friend. Of those completing the survey, 17 use the corridor daily; two use it monthly; and one uses it weekly.

## Summary of Findings

- Street lighting received the highest rating for short-term improvements.
- Turn lanes received the highest ratings for mid-term improvements.
- Sidewalks, traffic management and access management received the highest ratings for long-term improvements.

### Screen 2: Short-Term Conceptual Improvements

The Image Rating screen asked participants to rate their preference by marking strongly dislike, dislike, neutral, like or strongly like for conceptual short-term improvements. Five broad categories: multimodal, Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS), access management, lighting and signage, and intersection improvements were further detailed as follows:

- Multimodal: Pedestrian, Bicycle and Transit improvements in areas such as crosswalks, sidewalk connectivity, pedestrian crossing and transit stops.
- ITS improvements in areas such as communications and signalized intersections.
- Access management to include raised medians, improved driveway spacing and median openings from I-10 to North Loop Drive.
- Lighting and Signage to include street-lighting, street signs and speed limits.
- Intersection Improvements on Horizon Boulevard at Alameda Avenue, Kenazo Avenue and Ascension Street.




Participants in the pedestrian, bicycle and transit short-term conceptual improvements screen, rated crosswalks most favorably with transit stops second.























**EL PASO** - Community members are invited to participate in the second round of public meetings for the Horizon Corridor Master Plan. The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) El Paso District is developing the plan for approximately 9.4 miles of Horizon Boulevard (FM 1281) between Alameda Avenue (SH 20) in Socorro and Ascension Street in Horizon City.

The corridor, which links the communities of Horizon City, Sparks, and Socorro, is experiencing increased growth. The Corridor Master Plan has defined existing transportation challenges and opportunities along Horizon Boulevard and will evaluate possible solutions. It will also document and evaluate the community's future vision regarding transportation, and develop a set of recommendations to enhance safety and mobility. The Corridor Master Plan will also consider drainage implications of potential improvements.

“Crash rates in the corridor are above the Texas Rural Average,” said TxDOT El Paso District Engineer Bob Bielek. “While there are various proposed solutions, we have already obtained funding from The Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) to add raised medians for a divided highway along the corridor.”

The meetings are the second in a series leading to recommended solutions. Identical study information will be presented at each gathering. These meetings are in an open house format with maps, plan details and boards, and will be staffed by TxDOT and consultants ready to answer questions in English and Spanish. Businesses in the area are invited to a business open house in advance of the public meeting on January 30, 2019.

“Projected population and employment growth in the area is high,” added Bielek. “It is critical that businesses and area residents provide feedback on proposed short-, mid- and long-term alternatives.”

A third round of public meetings will be scheduled before summer and the master plan is expected to be complete in fall 2019.




**CRASH RATES (TRAFFIC CRASHES PER 100 MILLION VEHICLE MILES)**




**TYPES OF CRASHES**



# Horizon Boulevard (FM 1281) Corridor Master Plan Fact Sheet

## Overview

The Horizon Boulevard (FM 1281) corridor extends 9.4 miles from Alameda Avenue (SH 20) to Ascension Street. Horizon Boulevard connects the communities of City of Socorro, Sparks, and Town of Horizon City, as well as parks, schools, neighborhoods, and various businesses. The corridor is expected to experience increased growth in the future, with many new developments currently in the planning or construction phases. To better prepare for this growth, TxDOT is developing a Corridor Master Plan to identify current and future transportation needs along Horizon Boulevard.



## What is a Corridor Master Plan?

A Corridor Master Plan:

- Defines existing transportation challenges and opportunities and evaluates possible solutions.
- Documents and evaluates the community's future vision regarding transportation and develops a set of recommendations to enhance safety and mobility.
- Includes data collection, public outreach, analysis of current and future transportation needs, and identification of potential projects.
- The study is also considering the drainage implications of any potential improvements and is working in conjunction with other drainage studies in the area.

## Why is TxDOT Doing This Study?

TxDOT wants to maintain and enhance safety and efficiency along the corridor.

- The Horizon Boulevard corridor will experience increased future population and employment growth with new developments.
- This will result in more people and vehicles using the corridor including cars, freight trucks, buses, pedestrians, and cyclists. If nothing is planned, this new traffic will strain the efficiency, safety, and mobility of the corridor.
- The Horizon Boulevard Corridor Master Plan is identifying current and future traffic needs along Horizon Boulevard, and is providing a set of recommended projects and strategies for short-, mid-, and long-term implementation.

## How Can I Participate?

TxDOT is planning continuous outreach through a variety of means including public meetings, a business open house, coordination with local community leaders and government agencies, a project website, an online survey, social media blasts, and announcements in local newspapers. Community input will help TxDOT understand transportation issues along the corridor and shape potential improvement strategies.

## Stakeholder and Public Engagement

- The first Agency Working Group (AWG) meeting was held in January, 2018. The AWG was presented with existing conditions on the corridor and asked to develop goal areas for the plan.
- The first round of public meetings were held in February, 2018. The public was asked to prioritize the goals for the corridor and provide input on recommendations. Existing conditions along the corridor were also presented.


