



# PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE

## 2019 – 2022 Rural Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP)

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) El Paso District will conduct three public meetings at the following locations (**all meetings will have the same information**):

- Tuesday, April 24, 2018 from 4-6 p.m. at the Presidio Activity Center (dining area), 1200 E. O'Reilly St., Presidio, Texas.
- Wednesday, April 25, 2018 from 4-6 p.m., at the Marfa Visitor Center, USO Building, 302 S. Highland Avenue, Marfa Texas.
- Tuesday, May 1, 2018 from 4-6 p.m., at the Culberson County Courthouse, 300 La Caverna St. Van Horn, Texas.

The purpose of these meetings is to receive comments on the TxDOT El Paso District's **2019-2022 RTIP**. The District planning and programming territory is about 21,700 square miles covering six counties in the state of Texas; El Paso County, Hudspeth County Culberson County, Jeff Davis County, Presidio County, and Brewster County. The RTIP is a short-range program developed by the District in cooperation with rural planning organizations (RPO) that covers a four-year period and contains a prioritized listing of all projects proposed for federal funding and regionally significant projects proposed for state, federal, and local funding in all areas of the state outside of metropolitan planning areas. All interested community members are encouraged to attend the public meeting and provide feedback to the 2019-2022 RTIP. Written comments must be submitted and/or postmarked by **May 12, 2018** to be part of the official record; and should be mailed to the Texas Department of Transportation - El Paso, Attention: Hugo Hernandez RE: 2019-2022 RTIP, 13301 Gateway Blvd. West, El Paso TX 79928.
