




NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

SH 20 (ALAMEDA AVE.) PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM 0.142 MILES SOUTH OF FM 76 (DELTA DR.) TO 0.242 MILES SOUTH OF FM 76 (DELTA DR.) EL PASO, EL PASO COUNTY, TEXAS CSJ: 0002-01-095

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) would like to invite you to participate in a public hearing regarding the pedestrian improvements. The purpose of the hearing is to present the planned improvements for SH 20 (Alameda Ave.) from 0.142 miles south of FM 76 (Delta Dr.) to 0.242 miles south of FM 76 (Delta Dr.), in El Paso, El Paso County, Texas. The hearing will be held on Thursday, August 10, 2017 at the El Paso Community College Administrative Services Center Auditorium at 9050 Viscount Blvd., El Paso, Texas 79925. An open house will be held from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., to allow for questions and review of project exhibits. The formal public hearing presentation will begin at 6:00 p.m.

The existing facility is a six-lane roadway (three lanes in each direction) within a 80-foot right-of-way (ROW) consisting of 12 -foot wide travel lanes.

The proposed project will consist of extending the 4-5'x4' box culverts and 36" concrete pipe approximately 20 feet on either side of the roadway. This will provide adequate spacing for sidewalk connectivity across both structures. The majority of proposed transportation improvements would be constructed within existing ROW; however, approximately 0.3214 acre of additional right-of-way (ROW) would be required for proposed culvert improvements. Approximately 0.12512 acre of temporary construction easements and 0.3214 acre of permanent construction easement will be required. Information concerning services and benefits available to affected property owners and the tentative schedules for ROW acquisition and construction will be available at the public hearing and can also be obtained from the TxDOT El Paso District Office.



An approximate 0.3214 acre of land located on the Ascarate Wasteway and Valley Gate Lateral would be required for permanent incorporation into the proposed transportation facility. The lateral is part of the El Paso County Water Irrigation District (EPCWID) No. 1 system and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

Maps showing the project's location and geometric design will be available for viewing at the hearing. This information will also be available for public inspection at the TxDOT El Paso District Office located at 13301 Gateway Boulevard West, El Paso, Texas 79928-5410.

All interested people are invited to attend this public hearing. Verbal and written comments from the public regarding this project are requested and may be presented at the hearing or for a period of 15 calendar days following the hearing. Written comments may be submitted either in person or by mail to Levi Pavia, E.I.T., at the TxDOT El Paso District Office located at 13301 Gateway Boulevard West, El Paso, Texas 79928-5410. Written comments must be postmarked by Friday, August 25, 2017.

The hearing will be conducted in English. If English is not your primary language and you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, you may need an interpreter or document translator; one will be provided to you upon request. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can

be made to accommodate most needs.
