The Texas Department of Transportation ("TxDOT"), Fort Worth District, is conducting a Feasibility Study on BUS 377J (Washington Street) from Reta Avenue to US 281 in Stephenville, Erath County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an on-line virtual public meeting for your input on the recommendations prepared through the study. The virtual meeting will be open from **Thursday, Oct. 22, 2020 at 6 p.m. to Friday, Nov. 6, 2020 at 11:59 p.m.** To log onto the virtual public meeting, go to the following web address after the date and time indicated above: [www.txdot.gov](http://www.txdot.gov), and in the keyword search enter "BUS 377J Erath County". Staff will give a pre-recorded presentation regarding the study. The presentation will include both audio and visual components. If you do not have internet access, you may call Helen Tran at (817) 370-3513 for the project information during the Virtual Public Meeting period, from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. Formal comments may be provided by mail or email as explained below.

The study proposes improvements at multiple locations along the project limits to enhance mobility and safety. Proposed improvements include adding pedestrian facilities, improving existing roadway realignment, and adding turn lanes at several intersections. The study is approximately 2.9 miles in length.

Public Meeting Layouts, showing the study locations and recommended improvements, will be available online at the above TxDOT website during the virtual public meeting period.

The virtual public meeting will be conducted in English, and we will also have a Spanish version. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. If you need interpretation or translation services or you are a person with a disability who requires an accommodation to attend and participate in the virtual meeting, please call (817) 370-6817 no later than 4 p.m. CT, October 20, 2020. Please be aware that advance notice is required as some services and accommodations may require time for TxDOT to arrange.
