


FM 156 (BLUE MOUND ROAD) RECONSTRUCTION AND WIDENING

FORT WORTH DISTRICT



PROJECT OVERVIEW

Highway/Limits: FM 156 from US 81/US 287 to McLeroy Blvd./Watauga Rd.

Project ID: 0718-02-045

Project Length: Approximately 3.8 miles

Description: The proposed improvements would reconstruct and widen the existing two-lane roadway to a four-lane roadway with a raised median and left-turn bays at major cross street intersections. The proposed roadway would be constructed within a curb and gutter section and improvements would include sidewalks separated from the roadway and shared use outside lanes to accommodate bicyclists.

Construction Cost: The current estimated construction cost is \$53.1 million.

Right of Way: The existing typical right of way width is approximately 120 feet. The proposed improvements would require minor right-of-way acquisition of approximately 0.45 acres.

Finish Construction: 2022
