VIRTUAL PUBLIC MEETING
FM 4/FM 916 (East Criner Street)
Brick Pavement and Sidewalk Improvements
Johnson County, Texas
CSJs: 0712-01-041 and 0712-02-016**

The Texas Department of Transportation (“TxDOT”) is proposing improvements to Farm-to-Market (FM) 4/ FM 916 (East Criner Street) from South First Street to North Fourth Street in Johnson County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an online virtual public meeting on the proposed project. The virtual meeting will open on **July 16, 2020 at 6 p.m.** To log onto the virtual public meeting, go to the following web address after the date and time indicated above: www.txdot.gov, keyword search “FM 4/ FM 916”. Project staff will give a pre-recorded presentation regarding the project. The presentation will include both audio and visual components. If you do not have internet access, you may call 817-370-3570 to ask questions about the project and access project materials at any time during the project development process. Formal comments may be provided by mail or email as explained below.

The proposed project would improve mobility as well as enhance access and safety. The proposed improvements would include removing the existing brick to repair the base and subbase of the road. Original bricks would be reused to repave the roadway, and the sidewalks would be widened. The proposed improvements would also include installing or replacing ADA-compliant curb ramps. The existing utilities that are in conflict would be relocated. The project is approximately 0.16 miles.

Information about the proposed project will be available for public inspection from Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at Grandview City Hall at 1100 McDuff Avenue, Grandview, Texas 76050 or at the Grandview Fire Station at 100 East McFarland Street, Grandview, Texas 76050.

TxDOT makes every reasonable effort to accommodate the needs of the public. The virtual public meeting will be in English. If you have a special communication accommodation or need for an interpreter, a request can be made. Please be aware that advance notice of two (2) business days is requested as some accommodations may require time for TxDOT to arrange.
