



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING**  
**SH 199 at I-820 Interchange in Tarrant County**  
**SH 199: From Azle Avenue to Biway Street**  
**I-820: From Navajo Trail /Cahoba Drive to Marine Creek Parkway**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) proposes to reconstruct and expand SH 199 Interchange extending from Azle Avenue to Biway Street in Tarrant County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting a public meeting on the proposed project.

The meeting will be held on Tuesday, February 19, 2019 at Lake Worth High School at 4210 Boat Club Road, Lake Worth, Texas 76135. Displays will be available for viewing at 6 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. There will be no formal meeting presentation. The purpose of the meeting is to present the conceptual alternatives and to receive public comments on each.

The purpose of the project is to increase safety and mobility. Three (3) conceptual alternatives will be presented for viewing. These alternatives have various lane configurations with elements that include direct connectors, depressed lanes, diverging diamond intersections, pedestrian elements and ramp reversals.

Each of the conceptual designs would require the acquisition of additional right of way. Although additional right of way is required, no residential structures would be impacted. Depending on the alternative, various numbers of non-residential structures would be displaced. Information concerning services and benefits available to affected property owners and information about the tentative schedule for right of way acquisition will be available at the meeting or may be obtained from the district office at the address listed below.

The proposed project crosses a Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) designated 100-year floodplain, Zone A.

Environmental documentation or studies are currently being developed and will be available for viewing once the preferred alternative has been selected for further development.

The meeting will be conducted in English with Spanish interpreters in attendance. Persons interested in attending the meeting who have special communication or accommodation needs, such as the need for an interpreter, are encouraged to contact Mr. Sam Yacoub at (817) 370 - 6560. Requests should be made at least five (5) working days prior to the meeting. Every reasonable effort will be made to accommodate these needs.

Verbal and written comments from the public regarding the project are requested and may be presented at the meeting or submitted in person or by mail to the TxDOT Fort Worth District Office. Comments must be received on or before March 21, 2019 to be part of the official meeting record. Also, if you have any general questions or
