



**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING
US 281 at US 380 Intersection Improvements
Jack County, Texas**

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) proposes safety improvements for the intersection of US 281 at US 380 south of Jacksboro in Jack County, Texas. The purpose of the meeting is to present alternative designs and to receive public comment on the proposed project. The public meeting will be an open house format with no formal presentation held on:

The proposed alternatives would construct overpass bridges on US 281 over the existing intersection at US 380. This would improve safety and mobility by allowing US 281 through-traffic to flow through the area without stopping. In addition, one alternative would include new frontage roads along US 281 within the project limits to allow local travelers access to US 380 and adjacent properties. The proposed project would require the purchase of new right of way.

Maps and drawings reflecting the proposed alternatives will be displayed at the public meeting. The meeting will be an open house format allowing interested stakeholders to come and go at their convenience.

Verbal and written comments relative to the proposed alternatives may be presented at the public meeting.
